Application form:

Copy of passeport

A Curriculum Vitae

2 photos (with your name in the back).

Motivation letter

The Statement of Purpose (Motivation letter) should mention :

- your current studies or position,
- your field of interest,
- why you have chosen the Master in (please indicate which Master) of Telecom ParisTech,
- what would be your project upon graduation ...

Two letters of recommendation

At least one letter has to be written by a professor attesting the student's academic performances. The letter should be original and written on a letterhead of university/company.

The letter should mention the following information:

- your name
- the Master for which you are applying
- how they know you
- your approximate rank in your class
- your academic performance
- your personality

English proficiency Test document

This could include

- having English as your mother tongue
- studies in an majority English-speaking country
- acquisition of an English Language qualification (TOEFL : 550PBT or 213 CBT or 79-80 IBT/ IELTS : 5.5 / TOEIC :750 / Cambridge : CAE)*

**The English test score can be submitted after application but before the course starts*

¹ It is strongly advised to send documents with a return receipt or by courier, to secure their reception.

- **Certified copy of the transcripts of records** and certified translations in French or English (by an authority such as public notary or Embassy).
The certified copy has to be attested by the university of origin.
- **Detailed syllabus of the Bachelor program** (2-3 line-description of each technical course on the transcripts or in the Bachelor courses catalogue).
- **Certified copy of university degrees and previous education certificates** (high-school degree & Bachelor's degree if graduate) and certified translations in French or English.
- **Financial statement: Information on how you intend to meet tuition fees & living costs**
The student, parents or a sponsor sign a letter stating that they can support both the tuition fees and at least 775 Euros for monthly living expenses.
